At a meeting of the Diocesan Advisory Committee held on 15/07/2026

The following works or other proposals were considered:

Reordering and internal alternations within the interior north side of the church building: 1. Remove the pews and timber platforms in the north aisle, and level the floor. 2 Create an open meeting area, and introduce new chairs and tables (stored when not in use). 3. Dismantle the choir vestry (installed in 1954) at the west end of the aisle and create a kitchen and table store (incorporating original vestry screen and panels). 4. Install suspended infrared heaters within the reordered north aisle. 5. Modify the existing small kitchen at the east end of the aisle to become a vicar's vestry. 6. Enlarge the adjacent present vicar's vestry to become a choir vestry. All in accordance with drawing nos 164-01-06C, 164-01-07B, 164-01-08A, 164-01-09C, and 164-01-10B, by Cruciform (Architects) Ltd.

The works or proposals should be described in the petition for a faculty and in the public notice in the same way as they are described here.

The Committee recommends the works or proposals for approval by the court.

This advice does not constitute authority for carrying out the works or proposals and a faculty is required.

In the opinion of the Committee rule 9.9 of the Faculty Jurisdiction Rules (publication of notice on diocesan website) applies.

The works or proposals involve matters to which net zero guidance applies (that is, guidance issued by the Church Buildings Council under section 55 of the Dioceses, Pastoral and Mission Measure 2007 on reducing carbon emissions).
